Competitions:

10 km road race (athletes age 16 and up)

Start:

The race takes place on Saturday, July 13th. Start time is at 9:30am for all runners. The start is located 50m from the Institute of Sports and Sports Science (KIT Campus South, building 40.40). Address: Engler-Bunte-Ring 13, 76131 Karlsruhe

Finish is at the track and field stadium at KIT Campus South.

Registration:

Registration and results service is available through our homepage <https://www.kitsc.de/leichtathletik>. Registration fees are 7 € for students, 7 € for KIT employees, and 10 € for externals.

Registration deadline and late registration:

Registration deadline is Wednesday, July 10th or after the maximum number of 800 participants is reached.

Late registration will be possible during the distribution of the bib numbers on July 12th and on race day until 30 minutes prior to the start with an *additional* fee of 3 €.

Bib Number Pick Up:

You can get your bib number

- On Friday July 12th from 1pm to 2pm at the Institute for Sports and Sports Science (KIT Campus South, Building 40.40)
- Additionally, bib numbers can be picked up on race day from 8am to 9am at the Institute for Sports and Sports Science.

Course:

The officially certified course of 10 km length starts at Institute for Sports and Sports Science. The course is flat and exclusively on paved forest roads. Finish is in the track and field stadium at KIT-Campus South.

Time Measurement:

For each participant gross time is measured using an RFID chip integrated in the bib number. Please do not manipulate your bib number as this might damage the chip.

Classification:

Classification is separated into age categories following the [DLV rules](#). Additionally, the overall winners male/female and the fastest teams (consisting of the four fastest runners of each team) are determined.

Awards and Prize Money:

The fastest male and female KIT runners (KIT student or employee) are determined. He/she gets the title „KIT Meister/in 10 km 2024“. Additionally, the first three finishers of the overall race (male and female) are honored. Awards will also be given to the top three team.
